Air Mobility Operations Squadron (AMOS)

AFSC: 11M3T

Pilots mobility aircraft and commands crews to accomplish tanker, airlift, training, and other missions. These officers execute the essential airlift, mobility and air refueling operations that comprise the great majority of Air Force Reserve flying missions

MAJOR TASKS

- Plans and prepares for mission. Reviews mission tasking, intelligence, and weather information. Supervises mission planning, preparation, filing a flight plan, and crew briefing.
- Ensures aircraft is preflighted, inspected, loaded, equipped, and manned for mission. Pilots aircraft and commands crew.
- Ensures operational readiness of crew by conducting or supervising mission specific training.
- Develops plans and policies, monitors operations, and advises commanders. Assists commanders and performs staff functions related to this specialty.

- Bachelor's Degree
- Commission as an officer in USAF Guard/Reserves
- Completion of Air Force Specialized Undergraduate Pilot Training (SUPT)
- Qualification for Flying Class I
- Eligibility for Top Secret security clearance
- Minimum three (3) years experience as USAF Mobility
