It takes a cohesive team of trained, experienced professionals to consistently accomplish dangerous, complicated air missions. As an Airfield Operation Officer, you'll be a critical member of that team. In this role, you'll perform and lead airfield operations staff functions, airfield management, and airspace management within the National Airspace System and combat environments. You'll also advise commanders on the effective use of airfield operation assets. An Airfield Operations Officer is also a liaison between HHQ staff and the operational planners.

MAJOR TASKS

At the 183d Air Operations Group, you'll be developing and writing Air National Guard or Joint/Combined Forces plans, programs, and policies using your broad operations background and understanding of the entire spectrum of Air National Guard operational doctrine. To satisfy mission objectives, the depth and breadth of knowledge you will provide is critical, as is a thorough understanding of the knowledge needed to effectively deploy their multifunctional areas of responsibility.
